In accordance with your letter of January 3, an investigation has been made concerning the letters forwarded in connection with your application for commission in various departments of the Army.


In pursuance of our inquiries, this office has been informed by the Judge Advocate General of the Army that letters of recommendation filed by you were returned January 11, 1919, as follows:
