DELICITED TO JOIN YOUR CONNITTER TO DEFEND ANTRICA BY ADDING
THE ALLIES STOP UNLESS BRITAIN AND FRANCE WIN THIS WAR THE UNITED
STATES WILL BE CAUGHT ENTIRELY UNPREPARED TO DEFEND ITSELF ACAINST
THE VICTORIOUS DICTATORNHIPS STOP IT MUST BE OBVIOUS THEREFORE TO
THE CONGRESS AND THE PRESIDENT THAT IT IS THEIR URGENT DUTY TO
CUASE IMMEDIATE SHIPMENT TO THE ALLIES OF ALL OUR AIRCRAFT
MUNITIONS AND SUPPLIES THAT CAN POSSIBLY BE SPARED COMA TO PASS A
LAW THAT AMERICAN PILOTS MAY VOLUNTEER WITHOUT LOSING CITIZENSHIP
AND TO REPEAL ALL OUR NEUTRALITY LEGISLATION SO THAT AMERICAN
