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Anonymous Letter to Francis Mairs Huntington-Wilson, October 7, 1939

Dear Sir:-

In reading over your article of to day, one has reason to doubt the sincerity of your opinion when you say -quote-" The embargo contributes to the possible defeat of Great Britain and France and helps Hitler, because it arbitarily deprives the British and French of rights that are theirs under the International Law." " Great Britain and France have the ability to pay for American arms and munitions, the ships to carry them and the navy to convoy such ships."" <u>Nazi</u> Germany LACKS ALL THESE."

At the opening - to get the record right - this is the opinion of one more fair-minded American citizen and not a Hitlerite, however this Ala New Deal crap is stuff rather difficult to digest.
